WISCONSIN

Majestic Hills, Lake Geneva—Twenty-one inch base. Seven inches new snow. Skiing good.

Wilmot Ski Hills—Twenty-six inch base. Five to six inches new snow. Skiing good.

Telemark [Hayward]—Five to 13 inch base. One inch new snow. Skiing very good.

Rib mountain [Wausau]—Five inch base. Icy spots. Skiing fair.

Lockhaven [Spooner]—Six to 12 inch base. No new snow. Skiing good to excellent.

Squirrel Hill [Minocqua]—Five to 10 inch base. One inch new snow. Skiing good.

Slinger—Twelve inch base. Four inches new snow. Skiing good.

King's Gateway [Land O' Lakes]—Four to 10 inch base. Skiing good.

Mus-Ski mountain [between Sawyer and Woodruff]—Ten to 12 inch base. One to two inches new snow. Skiing good.

Trollhaugen [St. Croix Falls]—Three to eight inch base. Skiing good to very good.

Deep Ski Area [Colfax]—Two to 12 inch base. Skiing good.

Mount Ashwabay [Bayfield]—Five to 14 inch base. Skiing excellent.

Sheltered Valley [Three Lakes]—Seven to 10 inch base. One inch new snow. Skiing good.

Arapahoe basin — Fifty-six inch base. Six inches new snow. Skiing excellent.

Aspen—Sun Deck, 60 inch base; Midway, 48 inch base; Bottom slope, 30 inch base. Skiing excellent.

Berthoud Pass—Sixty-eight inch base. Skiing excellent.

Glenwood Springs—Upper, 56 inch base; Midway, 50 inch base; Lower, 30 inch base.
