## Hickory Hills Ski Slopes Open and Tow Is Working

Hickory Hills Ski slopes are now open and the tow is working.

Hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

The slopes are located 13 miles south on highway 21 off 412 and about two miles east on a county road. Signs have been erected to give directions.

### Equipment Available

Ski equipment is available to rent on a limited basis.

Beginning group lessons are available for \$2.50.

There is a fee of \$1.50 a day for tow service, or for a \$4 fee a person may receive a package of lessons and tow service.

### Operated by Club

The slopes are a beginner slope of 1,000 feet and an advanced beginner slope of 1,500 feet.

Cedar Mountain Ski Club operates the slopes and provides ski patrols and first aid.

Club membership is \$10 for individuals and \$15 for families for the season including all tows and use of the shelter.

Non-members can use the trailer under regulations of the park.
