The ski hill is especially adapted to beginning and intermediate skiers. It includes an 850-foot rope tow. There will be a \$3 per day charge for tow tickets.

Hours of operation will be: Noon to 10 p.m. weekdays, 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. weekends and holidays.
