## \$69,906 Allotted For County Roads

The U.S. Bureau of Public Roads has allocated \$7,538,744 to Michigan for use on its secondary roads during the 1960-61 fiscal year.

The amount represents about a two per cent decrease compared to the amount of federal aid apportioned for the state during the fiscal year ending next June 30, according to John C. Mackie, state highway commissioner. The reduction was due to an allocation next year for Alaska.

Of the money allocated to Michigan, the State Highway Department will keep \$2,981,553 for work on secondary roads under the state's jurisdiction. The remaining \$4,444,110 will be divided among the state's 83 counties, Mr. Mackie said.

The funds allocated to the counties must be matched by the state and county road commission on a 50-50 basis and may be used for construction purposes only.
