\$69,906 Allotted For County Roads

The U.S. Bureau of Public Of the money and Roads has allocated \$7,538,744 Michigan, the State Highway Department will keep \$2,981,ondary roads during the 1960-61 fiscal year.

The amount represents about a two per cent decrease compared to the amount of federal aid apportioned for the state during the fiscal year ending next June 30, according to John C. Mackie, state highway com-missioner. The reduction was due to an allocation next year for Alaska

553 for work on secondary roads under the state's jurisdiction. The remaining \$4,444,110 will be divided among the state's 83 counties, Mr. Mackie said.

The funds allocated to counties must be matched by the state and county road com-mission on a 50-50 basis and may be used for construction purposes only.
