ALPENA

One of Michigan's finest rinks is the illuminated, fast, huge rink at Mich-E-Ke-Wis Park.

Great snow-shoes rabbit hunting near Alpena! Try it, and you'll be converted. Ice fishing.

Alpena Ski Slope (12 miles west of city) available for public. No tow.

BAY CITY

Although primarily for local participation, outsiders are cordially invited to enjoy Bay City's Winter Sports development—three large, illuminated ice rinks—all with music over public address systems.

Ice fishing and spearing through the ice.

GAYLORD

A natural paradise for winter hunters and fishermen. Home of the Otsego Ski Club. Open to public is a new skating rink in town—100x250 feet. Ski club open weekends only.

GRAYLING

The Winter Sports Park is closed due to the needs of the war—but don't forget us. However, the natural facilities at the park, including marked ski trails and down hill courses, are available.

Winter hunters and fishermen are welcome.

PINCONNING

Want a real thrill? Arrange a fishing expedition to spear wall-eyed pike in Saginaw Bay. Ice skating in town near Pinconning's modern Northern Bay County Recreational Building.

SAGINAW

Twelve skating rinks—largest is Hoyt Park Center (12 acres of ice!) where may be found speed skating tracks, hockey court, toboggan slide and novice ski slides. New Field House. Music over P. A.

SILVER VALLEY

The roads will be cleared to enjoy the natural features of Silver Valley. Good skiing, sledding. Due to war manpower shortage—no toboggan or rink at Silver Valley.

On Tawas Bay, superb fishing for perch.

STANDISH

For years, Standish has built prestige as a stop and shop place, excelling in fine meals and service for the sportsman . . . local skating rink, ice fishing.

WEST BRANCH

Throughout the area near West Branch, the winter sportsman can hunt rabbits, wildcat and fox. Fishing through the ice for crappies and pike. Open season on bear in Ogemaw county. New skating rink in town. West Branch ski area open for special parties.
