

Munising: The city of Munising plans to dismantle its Maple Mountain ski hill operation after reaching a \$500,000 out-of-court settlement with the family of a 6-year-old boy who died at the hill in December.

The facility was shut down after Anthony Mazzali, of La Porte, Texas, was strangled by his scarf while using the rope tow two days before Christmas. The boy was visiting relatives in Munising with his mother.

An investigation by the state Department of Licensing and Regulation found numerous violations, including a lack of supervision and trained tow operators.
