PLANT TREES IN STATE FORESTS

Michigan's public lands recived another longranged boost this fall for multiple use when Conservation Department and inmate labor crews planted some 9.642,000 young trees on 12,172 acres in 15 northern states forests.

With optimum timber production, wildlife populations, and recreation use as the goals, some 3,148,00 seedlings and transplants were planted on 3,405 acres in seven upper peninsula state forests. Another 6,494,000 trees were planted on 8,767 acres in eight state forests of the northern lower peninsula.

Red pine seedlings made up the bulk of the state nursery plantings. Lesser amounts of white pine and jack pine seedlings and white spruce transplants and seedling rounded out the stock used.
