

Rockland's Ski Hill Is Ready

ONTONAGON — Jerome Hoeflerle, president of the Ontonagon County Tourist Association has announced that the Intermediate ski hill at Rockland will be ready for use on Sunday, January 26. The hill has a rope tow and is lighted for use in the evenings as well as during the day on week ends. Rates are \$1 for adults and \$.50 for students.

The Tourist Association has also announced the appointment of Neil Mayfield of White Pine as secretary-manager of the Tourist Association. This appointment is being made at a time when many of the skiing tourists are being turned away due to accommodation difficulties.
