

## Ski Club Has 25 Open Memberships

Ski enthusiasts are invited to attend Kandahar Ski Club's open house, Sunday, Dec. 10 from 1-5 p.m.

Kandahar is a membership owned club and a non-profit organization. In fact, the only private ski club in Southeast Michigan.

There are presently 325 members with 25 memberships open. The ski club is located approximately 4 miles south of Fenton, Michigan on Foley Road (formerly the location of the old Summit ski area). Kandahar was formed in 1937 - however, moved to its present Fenton location four years ago.

The area consists of 103 acres in which there are six open slopes and various trails serviced by a Pomalift on the main slope and eight electric tows on the other slopes.

The slopes range from a beginners run to a 1500 foot run with an approximate 200 foot vertical drop. Over half the slopes are serviced by snow-making equipment.

As an added attraction there is a 20 meter ski jump and the club is planning ski jump meets this winter.

To get to Kandahar: If you're coming from the west or south, travel north on US 23 past M 59 eight miles to the Center Road exit. Turn east on Center

Road one mile to Hartland Road. Then turn left on Hartland for 1/2 mile to Foley Road. Drive east 1/2 mile on Foley to the club.

If you're coming from the south or east, take M-59 to Fenton Road. Turn north on Fenton Road for eight miles to Foley Road and turn west for one mile to the club.

If you're coming from the east or northeast take I-75 to the Fenton exit. Turn west on Grange Road. Travel to Fenton and take Adelaide (Fenton Rd.) south 4 miles to Foley Road. Turn west for one mile to the club.
