

Sliding Spots For Children

Park Superintendent Gerald Williams today offered some suggestions on locations where youngsters can enjoy coasting.

In reply to a number of queries received regarding places where children can use their sleds or 'flying saucers' for coasting, Mr Williams stated that a coasting area is available on the hill just east of Division and south of Fourteenth street, site of the old Ci-Bo ski area.

He also said that lights are being left on in Hannah Park near the city library on Sixth street to provide night coasting for children on the park terraces. He cautioned that adults should accompany younger children to this spot because of the proximity of the river.
