

Ski Area Opens Near Belgrade

BELGRADE, Minn. — Following a slow start last year because of poor weather, a new skiing facility, the Nordmarken Ski Area, opened near here this month.

The area is located three miles west of the junction of Highway 71 and State Aid Road 9 in Kandiyohi County.

The skiing facilities were developed by three brothers-in-law, Dr. Gene R. Savelkoul, Belgrade, Ken Dalager and Jerry Brandby, Minneapolis.

Included in the skiing facilities are: three full ski runs and a beginners hill, with two tope tows operating. The longest run measures 1,200 feet in length with a drop of about 170 feet.

Rental equipment available at Nordmarken includes 50 sets of skis with Swiss ski boots in all sizes, balance poles and five to seven foot skis.

The chalet and rental shops have been completed and plans are being made to add snow making machines, more ski runs, and snowmobile trails in separate areas.
