

# Ski Improvements At Silver Slopes

Winona area skiers this winter will find many improvements at Silver slopes, skiing center eight miles west of the city on highway 61.

A 175-foot ski jump has just been completed and several tournaments are planned by Mr. and Mrs. William Lynch, operators of the ski area.

In addition, Lynch said a 700-foot toboggan shoot has been constructed. With electricity installed, the shoot will be lighted at night.

The 1,200-foot tow has been shortened to 900 feet. Lynch said this should insure better operation. A first aid room and living quarters for the Lynches have been added to the warming hut. The hut itself will be available for parties by ski groups.

The slalom hill has been enlarged to a width of 100 yards over a distance of 300 yards. There are parking facilities for more than 500 cars, Lynch reported.
