Silver Slopes Lodge Offers Free Lessons

All persons interested in learning how to ski can get free instructions at the lodge this week. The lodge will supply transportation service next Saturday and Sunday for those who could not otherwise get out to the Silver Slopes.

Lynch said the lodge will provide the use of its skis, boots, poles and the ski tow.

The lodge will have three instructors on hand to teach beginners. They are Irv Kilstoff, Roger Weeks and Art Speltz.

Since this is Girl Scout week, the lodge has set aside Tuesday as a special day for the scouts. The lodge will be open for instruction from 4:30 to 8:30 p. m.

Wednesday, 4:30 to 8 p. m.;
Friday, 4:30 to 8 p. m.; Saturday,
9 a. m. to 2 p. m., and Sunday 9 a. m. to 2 p. m.

The lodge also will be open Wednesday and Friday nights until 10:30 p. m.

Weekend transportation also will be provided Saturday and Sunday mornings. A station wagon will leave the Catholic Recreational Center at 9:15 a. m. Saturday and 11:30 a. m. Sunday.
