

U.S. Agency Rejects Fargo Ski Hill Plan

FARGO (AP)—Hopes have dimmed for federal assistance on a project that would have provided a man-made ski hill and recreational lake southwest of here.

The U. S. Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, which was asked to provide matching funds for the project, has rejected the application after its Denver regional director, Maurice Arnold, had issued favorable recommendation.

Arnold reported his superior's finding in a letter to John Greenslit, coordinator and liaison officer for the State Outdoor Recreation Agency.
