

\$500,000 Ski Hill Planned North of Lake Geneva

LAKE GENEVA—Plans for development of a ski hill at two farms on either side of Krueger Road in Bloomfield Township were revealed at a hearing before the Walworth County park commission this week.

Edwin Meltzer, the developer, said he will use a Japanese theme. Cost was estimated at \$500,000. Two slopes, a landing strip for planes, stables and bridle paths and snowmaking machines are planned, the commission was told. A dining room and club are is long-range plans.

New Highway 12 will cut across the southwest corner of one of the farms. The property, which is north of here, is presently zoned for agricultural purposes. Commerical zoning was asked.

The commission's recommendation on zoning will be presented to the Walworth County Board for final action.
