NORTHERNAIRE, Three Lakes, Wis.—Skiing fair; Ski hill packed; snow crusted for cross country run; fresh snow forecast; skating on illuminated rink excellent.

DRESSER, WIS.—Four to six inch packed base; skiing good.

MT. ASHWABAY, WIS.—Ski conditions good; 18 inches packed snow; forecast for light snow; tow operating Saturday and Sunday.

HAGEN-MINER ski area, Rice Lake Wis.—Ski hill now in operation; snow conditions good. Ski chalet and ski shop open; tow 3,000 feet.

MONT DU LAC, Ojibway ski bowl, Duluth Area—Two to 12 inch packed base; all ski tows in operation; new snow forecast for week-end.

LAND O'LAKES, WIS.—Packed surface snow. Skiing good. Temperature 15 to 16 above.

LUTSEN, MINN.—Temperature 23. Snowing lightly. One inch powder snow atop 6-to-15 inch base. Skiing good to excellent.

TELEMARK, Hayward, Wis.—Skiing good to excellent on 10 to 13 inch base. Snow predicted tonight.
