## JACKSON HOLE ECONOMY HITS NEW HEIGHTS

Teton Village, Wyo., Feb. 8 [Special]—The town of Jackson, Wyo., has been given a big economic boost by the Jackson Hole Ski corporation with spending during the winter months almost tripled since the ski area first opened for business in December of 1966.

Figures provided by the Wyoming state department of revenue showed that during the December-March period the winter before the ski area opened, \$45,232 in sales tax and use tax had been collected in Teton county, the county in which the ski area and town are located.

During the winter season of 1966-67, revenue collected had soared to \$112,231.
