

Carroll Board To Consider Tax Extension

MOUNT CARROLL — Carroll County Board of Supervisors has voted to consider an extension of county sales taxes at its next meeting.

A resolution will be prepared extending the one-half cent per dollar county rate to sales made outside the cities and villages. At present the tax covers only sales within the corporate limits of cities and villages.

Theodore R. Haller, Chicago, was granted a class A liquor license for his Mississippi Palisades Ski Resort.

Charles E. Kessler Sr., and Mrs. Ray Pohill were reappointed to the advisory board and Mrs. G. C. Poppenhouse was reappointed to the welfare services committee.

Three culverts were approved for construction. They are Elkhorn Grove Township, over the branch of Eagle Creek, \$1500, and over a branch of Elkhorn Creek, \$1800; and Woodland Township, over a branch of the Plum River, \$1500.

A resolution was passed providing that the floor be tiled, the ceiling lowered and a dais built in the present officers of associate Judge Edward J. Turnbaugh.
