

# Board Accepts Whiteside Proposal to Improve Road; Name Commission Members

## Two New Board Members Shimer College

Carroll county supervisors Tuesday adopted a resolution concurring in plans of Whiteside county for improvement of the Chadwick - Morrison road. Whiteside plans to make extensive improvements on the road, portions of which now are paved for but half the road width in that county, and has offered to improve approximately 80 feet of the road which is in Carroll county and forms a connecting link between the Carroll county blacktop road and Whiteside county's portion. Cost of the work will be paid by Whiteside county.

Carroll board members also adopted a resolution fixing weight limits for vehicles using county roads during the period of spring thaw. These limits are the same as those in effect in 1964, and signs bearing this information will be posted soon on the roads.

In other action at the February board meeting, chairman Howard Woessner announced the appointment of Supervisors Homer Zuck, Louis Rabun and Russell Rahn to a committee on civil defense.

Woessner also named to three year terms on the Carroll County Planning Commission Henry Sorensen of Lanark, Ben Fecke of Mt. Carroll, W. J. Schreiner of Chadwick and Sheldon Helle of Savanna.

Appearing before the board to seek issuance of a liquor license for the Savanna Valley Sports Area were Ted Haller and Clifford Rahn. The Sports Area is being developed at a site north of Palisades State Park. Supervisors deferred action on the request until the next meeting.
