

Ski Area Added At Lake Gogebic

BESSEMER—Construction of a new ski slope, south of the State Park on M-28, near Weber's Lake Gogebic resort, has been completed, according to the report of the conservation committee given to the Gogebic county board of supervisors, yesterday.

The brushing and bulldozing was done through the courtesy of the Marquette Township board.

The slope is well located. It can be reached conveniently by a 10 minute walk from the highway. The ski run is about 1,400 feet, and can be extended about 500 or 600 feet more. The slope of the incline allows a speed of from 50 to 60 miles per hour. Members of the committee expressed the opinion that it is equal to some of the best ski-slopes in the state.

Supervisor B. J. Conterio, Marquette, said that investigation is underway to provide a ski-lift before the slope is opened up.

The committee further reported that the county ski-trail, which begins in Verona and travels north for a distance of 14 miles, west of a parallel with the Presque Isle Road, will be opened to the public in the near future. The only work remaining to complete the trail is posting of signs and markers.
