At the St. Paul 3M Club's Tartan Park a 24,000 square-foot recreation center, now under construction, will be finished this fall. Tartan Park has an 18-hole golf course, a ski chalet and picnic pavilion. Besides golf and skiing, it also offers members archery, tennis, volleyball, badminton, softball, baseball, skiing and skating.

THE CLUB'S 12,000 members can choose from a wide range of recreational activities—from stamp collecting and ice hockey to choral singing and sailboating.

Major categories include sports (both commercial and intramural), music, club and hobby activities.

Revenue for the 3M Club comes from \$1 annual membership dues and commissions from vending machines in all 3M locations. Fees are charged for golf. Land for Tartan Park was purchased by the company in 1959 and was later turned over to a foundation, which is holding it in a trust dedicated to employee recreation as "green space."
