Snow Train to Arrive at Sartell Sunday, 10 A. M.

Seventeen coaches, carrying nearly 1,000 Minneapolis people, will arrive at Sartell Sunday morning at 10:15 as the start of another big day at Winter Haven.

The Northern Pacific "Snow" train, chartered by the Minneapolis Junior Chamber of Commerce, will also bring a Minneapolis marching unit and queens, one of whom will be selected to reign over the day's festivities.

Upon arrival at the station in Sartell, the passengers on the snow train will parade to Winter Haven behind the Brainerd Ladies' drum corps, the St. Cloud VFW drum corps and the Little Falls ski patrol.

After the parade, the group will attend church services at 11, and at 11:30 a.m. serving of a huge ham dinner will be started.

Scheduled for 1:30 is "Ice Fantasy," to be presented at the picturesque Winter Haven skating rink by the St. Cloud Figure Skating club. This will be followed by the crowning of the Snow Train Queen at Sunset Lodge. Queens will be judged en route on the train.

From 2:30 to 5:30 p.m. the Minneapolisians will participate in outdoor sports such as skating, tobogganing and skiing and also be entertained at the village hall in Sartell. At 6 p.m. the train leaves again for Minneapolis.
