

VALLEY CITY SKIERS MEET

Tournament Is Planned For Feb. 10; John Sad Named New Head

Valley City, N. D., Jan. 5.—Feb. 10 has been tentatively set as the date for the Olympic Sports club ski tournament to be held on the Valley City ski jump, according to a decision reached at the organization meeting. The other date pending is the Feb. 3, but in all probability the invitation meet will run off the 10th as originally planned.

Officers were elected also at the business meeting this week. John Sad was named president, succeeding Leo Brady. Other officers elected are S. Sigurdson, vicepresident; R. Kenneth McFarland, secretary-treasurer, and the following board of directors: Oscar Dahl, N. M. Neilson, Ole Hovde, T. Stone, Leo Brady.

The club, which was organized here three years ago, will promote all branches of winter sports namely, skating, tobogganing, hockey and skiing. An ice carnival will be staged in the near future, these arrangements being in charge of John Johnson, George Hardwick and Dr. A. O. Scheldahl. A toboggan slide will be erected on Sugar Loaf hill and a small ski jump for the younger enthusiasts will be erected. Lloyd Thompson and L. D. Rhodes have been placed in charge of the tobogganing activities by the club.

A new hill has been erected here and the new jump should promote some fine records in the coming tournament. Several new state records were established here at the last meet two years ago. Added interest in the local club has been given through the recent acquisition of Trygve Stone of Fargo and Ole Hovde of Kathryn, well known ski jumpers who have established records at many meets.

It was also decided to invite the National Ski tournament here for 1929.
