Ski resorts continuing to expand

Resort operators in Eastern Ontario and West Quebec are improving facilities continuously. Resorting is big money, and improvements run into hundreds of thousands of dollars.

Following is a selection of ski areas, principally alpine skiing, but some offer cross country trails as well.

A list of 17 ski hills in Eastern Ontario follows. The numbers relate to the accompanying map:

(1) Rolphton: *Big Valley Ski Hill*, seven miles north off access Hwy. 635. Vertical drop 275 feet, maximum length 1,000 feet. Lifts, one rope. 586-9317.

(2) Deep River: *Mount Martin Ski Club*, one mile west off access Hwy. 17. Vertical drop 150 feet, maximum length 700 feet. Lifts, one T-bar, one rope. 687-2516.

(3) Petawawa: *Petawawa Ski Club*, three miles west off access Hwy. 17. Vertical drop 120 feet, maximum length 500 feet. Lifts, one rope. 687-2516.

(4) Pembroke: *Alice Hill Park*, 14 miles southwest off access Hwy. 62. Vertical drop 210 feet, maximum length 2,000 feet. Lifts, one T-bar, one rope. 732-2776.

(6) Barry's Bay: *Mount Madawaska Ski Resort*, three miles south off access Hwy. 62. Vertical drop 386 feet, maximum length 4,500 feet. Lifts, one T-bar, one rope. 756-2931.

(7) Dacre: *Candiac Skiways*, three miles southeast off access Hwy. 132. Vertical drop 621 feet, maximum length 7,000 feet. Lifts, two T-bars. 432-2262.

(8) Calabogie: *Calabogie Peaks*, three miles west off access Hwy. 508. Vertical drop 750 feet, maximum length 6,600 feet. Lifts, four T-bars, one rope. 752-2720.

(9) Pakenham: *Mount Pakenham*, two miles southwest off access Hwy. 29. Vertical drop 300 feet, maximum length 2,500 feet. Lifts, double chair, one T-bar, one rope. 624-5290.

(10) Belleville: *Oak Hill Ski Club*, 10 miles north off access Hwy. 14. Vertical drop 210 feet, maximum length 1,600 feet. Lifts, three ropes. 395-3222.

(11) Batawa: *Batawa Ski Club*, five miles north off access Hwy. 33. Vertical drop 180 feet, maximum length 700 feet. Lifts, one T-bar, two ropes. 398-6568.

(12) Pictou: *Macauley Mountain Ski Club* on

Union Road off access Hwy. 33. Vertical drop 200 feet, maximum length 1,500 feet. Lifts, one T-bar, one rope. 476-8943.

(13) Napanee: *Nacoma Ski Hill*, three miles north off access Hwy. 401. Vertical drop 160 feet, maximum length 1,200 feet. Lifts, one poma, one rope. 378-2690.

(14) Kingston: *Kingston Ski Hills*, 20 miles north on Sydenham Road off access Hwy. 38. Vertical drop 135 feet, maximum length 900 feet. Lifts, one T-bar, three ropes. 542-7166.

(15) Athens: *Y Ski Centre*, five miles west on

Hwy. 42. Vertical drop 125 feet, maximum length 600 feet. Lifts, one rope. 342-7961.

(16) Smiths Falls: *Sugar Bush Hill Park*, one mile northwest of access Hwy. 15. Vertical drop 75 feet, maximum length 900 feet. Lifts, three ropes. 283-0785.

(17) South March: *Ottawa YMCA Ski Centre*, three miles north of Township Road access Hwy. 17. Vertical drop 100 feet, maximum length, 1,000 feet. Lifts, one T-bar, one J-bar, 832-1234.

(18) Ottawa: *Carlington Ski Hill*, Kirkwood and Queensway. Vertical drop 100 feet, maximum length 650 feet. Lifts, one rope. 729-8202.

There are eight nearby areas in west Quebec:

(5) Fort Coulonge: *Mount Chilly Ski Resort*, three miles north of village access Hwy. 8. Vertical drop 500 feet, maximum length 4,000 feet. Lifts, one T-bar. 732-2996.

(19) Chelsea: *Camp Fortune*, 15 miles northwest of Hull access Hwy. 5. Vertical drop 720 feet, maximum length 7,040 feet. Lifts, double chair, triple chair, one poma, four T-bars. 827-1717.

(20) Cantley: *Mont Cascades*, 12 miles northwest of Hull via Hwy. 105 access Hwy. 307. Vertical drop 500 feet, maximum length 4,000. Lifts, triple chair, double chair, one poma, two T-bars. 827-0136.

(21) Cantley: *Edelweiss*, 18 miles northwest of Hull via Hwy. 105 access Hwy. 307 at Wilson's Corners. Vertical drop 650 feet, maximum length 6,000 feet. Lifts, double chair, two pomas, four T-bars. 459-2859.

(22) Wakefield: *Vorlage*, 20 miles northwest of Hull via Hwy. 5 access Hwy. 105. Vertical drop 465 feet, maximum length 5,280 feet. Lifts, double chair, six T-bars. 459-3241.

(23) Kazabazua: *Mont Sainte-Marie*, 55 miles northwest of Hull via Hwy. 5 access Hwy. 105. Vertical drop 1,250 feet, maximum length 8,000 feet. Lifts, three double chairs, one poma. 467-2812.

(24) Masson: *Lac de l'Argile Resort*, 50 miles northwest of Masson access Hwy. 309. Vertical drop 415 feet, maximum length 6,000 feet. Lifts, one T-bar. 766-2341.
