

Businessmen Hear Of New Ski Resort In Wiarton Area

WIARTON — James Rodgers a Toronto lawyer, spoke on skiing at the regular meeting of the Wiarton Businessmen's Association Monday in the council Chambers. The speech was in conjunction with a proposed ski resort in the Lake Charles area about 10 miles east of Wiarton.

Mr. Rodgers told the meeting that ski lifts in the Collingwood area are unable to accommodate all the skiers. Skiing is a family sport and large snow fall in this area makes conditions ideal, he said. The vertical descent at new resort, to be called the Bruce Meadow's Ski Area, is 40 feet, he continued. The runs are about one-third of a mile. Charles Warder is the manager of the project.

Final plans were made for Santa Claus day in Wiarton. Bob Murrell reported costumes available from Ken Ringrose. A candy bagging bee will be held November 28 when 1,600 bags will be made up. The Christmas promotion will go into effect Tuesday.

In the promotion \$50 draws will be held November 30 and December 7 and 14. A \$75 draw will be made December 21. The winner of this will also receive two tickets to an NHL hockey match.
