



Ontario offers 105 prime ski areas, most of them on your doorstep

to three slopes at Loretto Ski Resort.

In the Barrie area, Snow Valley boasts a new hill and added snowmaking. Mount St. Louis has a new hill, expanded snowmaking, a larger chalet and improved parking, and Horseshoe Valley has extended snowmaking to cover five hills.

Manitowish Skis now has a new chair, extended snowmaking and enlarged parking.

In the Collingwood district, new slopes have been opened at Blue Mountain Winter Park, with new hill grooming equipment in service.

vice of Craigholm Ski Club and chalet and terrain improvements completed at Georgian Peaks.

Beaver Valley Ski Club, Fieserter-Markdale, has a improved chalet facilities and has purchased new grooming equipment.

Talman Ski Resort has 10 motel units added to its dining facilities and meeting rooms.

NORTH CENTRAL—In addition to the new Holiday Inn, the Hidden Valley Ski Resort will add a new run with a J-bar lift to its existing two chairlifts. Pacer, a beginner's rope tow and snowmaking equipment.

That's what's happening in Southern Ontario, where 105 Muskoka resorts

with modern accommodations as well as daily Tour or poma lift service include Muskoka Sands Resort, Britannia, Lumberport Lodge and Talley-Ho Inn.

Modern facilities are also offered at Sir Sam's Inn, Haliburton, and Hotel Bernard, Sundridge. The latter resort has also installed a new poma lift and snowmaking equipment.

Closer to home, here's a round-up of all centres in and around Metro Toronto.

Don Valley Ski Centre—Located at the Don Valley Parkway and Lawrence Ave. E., you can reach it by taking the subway to Eglinton Ave. and transferring to a Lawrence Ave. bus. The centre is one of Ontario's best ski spots. Most nights the hill is covered

with skiers. Facilities include a poma lift and four rope tows as well as snowmaking equipment.

Forest Valley—On Blue Forest Dr., a mile north of Highway 401 via Bathurst, Sheppard and Wellington.

Rouge Valley Ski Centre—This is a complex (traced by Sheppard Ave. E. and Midland Ave.) off Markham terrace class for ladies.

It is a P-1—Located a mile northeast of Maple via

the Richmond Hill/Maple stretch of Dufferin St. Much of the hill was made up of a half million cubic yards of earth. Six lifts, three of them poma, service six runs.

Rouge Valley Ski Centre—This is a complex (traced by Sheppard Ave. E. and Midland Ave.) off Markham terrace class for ladies.

It is a P-1—Located a mile northeast of Maple via

snowmaking and ice pulverizing equipment. Runs are up to 800 feet in length.

Uplands Ski Club—Located at Uplands Golf Club in Thornhill, it is expected to be operating by Christmas.

For the location of Southern Ontario's other centres check the map above.

And for a portable, com-

plete list of Ontario ski centres write the Department of Tourism and Information, 100 Street E., Toronto, and request a copy of a booklet called Ontario Ski Facilities 1968. It will be available late this month. It lists the runs and lifts, only lists equipment but tells such details as lift prices, which can be pretty important.
