

Variety of downhill areas available

Wisconsin offers many downhill ski areas. They are listed here courtesy of the state Division of Tourism.

Ski areas are:

1. Alpine Valley, (414) 842-7374 or (414) 933-4181. Open 10 a.m.-11 p.m. weekdays and 9 a.m.-11 p.m. weekends. Eight runs with longest 3,300 feet and a vertical drop of 288 feet. Five rope tows, 11 double, one triple and one quad chairlifts. Also available is cross country skiing.

2. Birch Park, (715) 549-4777. Open daily and all nights. Eighteen runs with longest 2,000 feet and drop of 230 feet. One T-bar, eight rope tows and three double chairlifts.

3. Bruce Mound, (715) 743-2400. Open 11 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays. Seven runs with longest 2,500 feet and 300-foot drop. Two T-bars and two rope tows. Also available cross country skiing, skating and tubing.

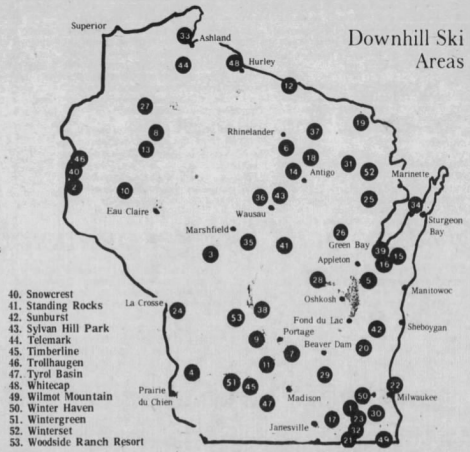
18. Kettlebowl, (715) 623-3560. Open noon-4 p.m. weekends. Five runs with longest 2,000 feet. Five rope tows.
