

## Calumet, Greenbush Ski Hills

Two popular ski hills in the Sheboygan area are located in the Kettle Moraine area near Greenbush and the Calumet County Park on Lake Winnebago.

Over 100 skiers used the three available runs at the Greenbush hill on New Year's Day and a good turnout was reported for the week end. The site has a good snow base and is open week ends from 10 a.m., to 4:30 p.m., along with other days as well. Skiers have their choice of two steeply-sloped hills plus still another with a through-the-trees route. There is a tow-rope.

Three slopes, 1,500 feet in length with two tows, are available at the Calumet site nine miles northwest of Chilton or two miles north of Stockbridge on Highway 55. There is also a beginner's slope. The hills are lighted so that skiing is possible on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday nights, besides week ends during the day. There is no charge for the use of the slopes, although there is a \$1 tow charge for the day.

Both hills have warming houses for refreshments.
