You can snowmobile, ski, toboggan in county

If skiing, tobogganing or snowmobiling are the winter sports that lure you outdoors, know that there are quite a few places in Waukesha County that offer facilities for at least one of the three activities and sometimes for two.

According to the Waukesha County University Extension Service bulletins, space to buzz around on that snowmobile is available at a half-dozen locations in the county. Two of them — one near Eagle, the other near Ottawa — are free to the public — that is the part of the public that owns snowmobiles.

At the others charges range from \$3 per season to snowmobile owners to \$10 an hour for rentals.

Incidentally, the Extension Service points out, no endorsement of the facilities is intended by the listings in the bulletins.

If you're looking for slopes that offer skiing exclusively, you'll also have to pay for it. There's either a clubhouse or tow charge at all three of the county ski hills listed on the map.

However, if you're willing to allow for tobogganers zipping nearby (but not too near) as you soar on the slopes, why, the parks that offer both skiing and tobogganing have no charge whatsoever.

And, too, the parks that offer tobogganing alone charge nothing for the facilities.
