54 Wisconsin Ski Hills 'Better Than Ever'

Fifty four Wisconsin ski hills will be better than ever this season.

New chairlifts, new and more instructors and more hours of skiing have been added at many ski areas, and 16 of them now offer cross country facilities... the newest craze in the sport.

New chairlifts are installed at Alpine Valley, Devil's Head, Mt. Telemark, Skyline, Whitecap, Mt. La Crosse and Hiawatha Hills, and many areas, including Hidden Valley, have stepped up their snowmaking production.

New slopes have been added at Eagle Bluff, Hardscrabble, Harrison Hills, Paradise Valley, Rib Mountain, Snowcrest and Viking. And, snowmaking equipment will be improved at Hiawatha Hills, Timberline and Hidden Valley.
